Special Information: 9 Man Ineligible Flag Football rules are available at www.bigskygames.org under Sport/Flag Football. Participants must be 16 years and older. Teams can be co-ed. Teams will be seeded in the tournament on Sunday from the results of two qualifying games played on Saturday, with the more competitive teams placed in the 1st Division and the less competitive teams placed in the 2nd Division. Teams with the best record in each Division advance in the tournament for medal round qualification. Games are 25 minute halves with a five minute half time. The clock runs continuously except for kick offs and extra points until the last two minutes when it is regulated normally. The rules do not allow any of the body contact techniques associated with regular contact football. There is no hitting, forearms, elbows, shoulders, or hips of any kind allowed. Rules will be strictly enforced! Violators will be held personally and legally responsible for their actions.

Guaranteed two games (A bye is considered a game). Any team five minutes late will be considered to have forfeited. Teams must check in fifteen (15) minutes before game by reporting to scoring table with a typed or printed team roster prior to each game played. Roster must be identical to entry form roster.

Roster changes: A **\$10 fee** will be charged for roster changes. Roster changes must be submitted in writing prior to the first game in the division to the BSSG office. Changes subject to BSSG approval.

Equipment: Each team member must wear a **numbered** jersey or T-shirt. Arrive at the site dressed to play. No locker rooms or towels will be provided. Bring your own practice balls and game ball. No steel cleats allowed. Mouth guards are recommended. **BRING YOUR OWN WATER AND SHADE.**

Officiating: All officials are MOA members and are the final authority of the game. These officials have volunteered their time. Please thank them after the game no matter the outcome.

SPORTSMANSHIP AND CONDUCT: *Good sportsmanship is required when addressing volunteer officials and scorekeepers. Unsportsmanlike conduct is not acceptable and will be penalized as deemed appropriate by the officials.*
